

# TAKE ONE ACTION: SLIDING SCALE TICKET PRICES

In order to make our events more accessible we are introducing a sliding scale ticket policy at all our non-cinema venues: audiences choose what they pay based on personal circumstance. You won't be asked for any proof or ID, all we ask is that you be honest with yourself and your financial situation.

## £0 - £2

---

- I am unable to meet my basic needs\*.
- I have debt and it sometimes prohibits me from meeting my basic needs.
- I rent lower-end properties or have unstable housing.
- I am receiving ESA/JSA/UC, DLA/PIP, or working tax credits.
- I am unemployed or on low income.
- I use food banks.
- I have no access to savings.
- I have no or very limited expendable\*\* income and walk because I can't afford public transport.
- I rarely buy new items because I am unable to afford them.
- I cannot afford a holiday or to take time off without financial burden.

## £4 - £6

---

- I may stress about meeting my basic needs but I still achieve them.
- I may have some debt but it does not stop me meeting my basic needs.
- I am employed.
- I have access to financial savings.
- I have some expendable\*\* income.
- I can afford public transport. If I have a car/access to a car I can afford petrol.
- I shop new and second-hand.
- I can take a holiday annually or every few years without financial burden.

## £8

---

- I am comfortably able to meet all of my basic needs.
- I may have some debt but it doesn't stop me meeting my basic needs.
- I own my home or property or I rent a higher-end property.
- I have savings and an expendable\*\* income.
- I can afford public and private transport. If I have a car/access to a car I can afford petrol.
- I can always buy new items if I need to.
- I can afford an annual holiday or to take time off.

\***BASIC NEEDS** include food, housing, clothing, and transportation.

\*\***EXPENDABLE INCOME** might mean you are able to buy coffee or tea at a shop, go to the cinema or a concert, buy new clothes, books and similar items each month, etc.
